Queensland Health aims to deliver the best population health services nationally; improve the health and wellbeing of the population; and reduce the health status gap between the most and least advantaged in the community. This will require increased funding allocated to the Prevention, Promotion and Protection Program, the introduction of new and enhanced services, additional workforce and infrastructure.

The Population health vision is 'Healthy Communities, Healthy People – focusing on: promoting health and wellbeing; preventing illness and injury; reducing health inequalities; and creating safe and healthy environments. The *Queensland Health Population Health Plan 2007-2102* identifies the major reform agenda and key investment priorities for Queensland Health's population health services over the next five years which are critical to achieving this vision.

The broadcast will outline the service development and enhancement priorities and the system enablers which support these changes across Queensland Health's population health function. It will have a particular focus on the implementation of the Population Health Plan at statewide and Area Health Service levels. The following issues will be discussed during the broadcast:

- Service development and enhancement priorities
- System enablers which support service changes
- Implications of the Population Health Plan for service planning, particularly within Area Health Services and departmental enabling plans
- Monitoring and reporting of progress against the Population Health Plan.
